



Minor in Political Communication

The Departments of Communication and Political Science and International Relations jointly offer a minor in Political Communication. This minor provides University of Delaware undergraduates with the opportunity to experience multidisciplinary teaching and research in the leading edge concepts of political communication and digital technology, as expressed and experienced in political campaigns and public policy debates at the local and national levels. In particular, the minor allows Communication and Political Science majors to specialize in Political Communication as well as making the field accessible to students from other majors. The minor encourages University of Delaware students to become leaders in this rapidly developing field.

IMPORTANT NOTES: Students must complete 28 credits before declaring the Political Communication minor. Only three courses or 9 credits may be in a student's major or cross listed with a student's major. Students who double major in Political Science and Communication are not eligible for the Political Communication minor.
